Keep Water Moving and Clean

Think of your pool’s pump and filter like a heart and kidneys: they keep your water clean, healthy, and inviting. Good circulation helps prevent algae, bacteria, and debris from building up. Weekly checks of your pump, skimmer, filter, and return jets are essential to ensure everything is working properly. Also, make sure the water level is high enough for the system to operate efficiently.

Balance Water Chemistry for Crystal Clarity

Perfectly clear water doesn’t happen by accident. Test your pool water weekly to ensure the pH sits between 7.2 and 7.6. If it’s too low, the water can become corrosive. If it’s too high, chlorine becomes less effective and cloudy water can develop.

Use chlorine, salt, or bromine as your sanitizer—whichever your system is designed for—and aim to keep chlorine levels between 1 and 4 ppm. Inconsistent chemical levels can lead to irritation, algae growth, or damage to pool finishes. At Premier One Pools, we recommend keeping a test kit on hand and checking water quality weekly for the best results.

Simple Cleaning Habits that Make a Big Difference

- Use a long-handled brush to scrub walls and steps once a week. This reduces scale buildup and boosts chemical efficiency.
- Skim the surface of the water regularly to remove leaves, bugs, and other floating debris.
- Empty your skimmer baskets at least once or twice a week to ensure your filtration system works effectively.
- Consider an automatic pool cleaner to handle the day-to-day debris removal with minimal effort.

How the Weather Impacts Your Pool

Nature plays a big role in pool maintenance. Windy days can fill your pool with leaves and pollen. Rain can dilute your chemicals. Hot, sunny stretches increase chlorine breakdown and evaporation—making it easier for algae to take over. After major weather events, test your water and clear out debris to get everything back in balance quickly.

- After heavy rain: test your pH and chlorine levels and skim debris promptly.
- During heat waves: check chemical levels more frequently as chlorine is used up faster.
- Windy days: skim the surface often and empty skimmer baskets to prevent clogs.
